Judging Process

The Stage's nationwide network of critics identifies eligible actors and creatives at every show they review.

An open nomination process runs alongside this to ensure every debutant can put themselves forward.

The eligible nominees are longlisted after consultation with expert advisors. A judging panel then meet to decide the shortlist and winners, who are announced at The Stage Debut Awards ceremony.

Criteria

Anyone aged 16 or over, making their professional theatrical debut in the UK is eligible. For acting roles this should be a first named role.
